Dear Mr. Rudolf:

On Wednesday, April 19, between the hours of 8:30 and 11 am, a search was made of all the rooms of the Grabert Publishing Company in Tübingen..

The object of the search was your "Lectures."

The search was carried out under a court order (Az # 4 Gs 312 / 2000) dated 12 April 2000 authorized by Judge Stein of the District Court of Tübingen, issued in response to a request by the State Prosecutor for Tübingen (Az: 15 Js 4446 / 98.)

The search was executed in conjunction with an investigation of Mr. Grabert and you on the complaint of "Incitement of the People," among other complaints.

Four books were confiscated.

In the seventeen page list of grounds for the search, many passages of the book were specified and "indirect denial" was emphasized.

The list of grounds states that the material seized creates the impression that "a deliberate, systematic and planned extermination of Jews did not take place."

The list of grounds admits that "nowhere in the work is this directly stated."

However, the list of grounds states that from the content of the material seized the idea (that "a deliberate, systematic and planned extermination of Jews did not take place") is developed "unmistakably and without doubt, from the objective content of statements as they would be understood by a competent and impartial third person."

The officials have established that for several years, no more copies have been delivered or received.

Otherwise, how are things going with you?
